- 1. Explain your reasons for applying to this particular Internship. Why do you want to work with PAGE and serve girls and young women of Appalachia?
- 2. Describe any background, experiences, or knowledge that could enhance your ability to contribute to the PAGE non-profit in a meaningful way.
- 3. Discuss any interest(s) you have in particular leadership opportunities with PAGE 2025. (Note: Feel free to express your interest in *more than one* role!)
 - ♦ Helping girls collect and preserve stories around Appalachian foodways and/or craft, including using audio equipment to record interviews with local makers and artisans
 - ♦ Helping PAGE girls engage in creative ways with STEAM/science and arts (E.g., in PageLabs involving ecology, biology, or natural science)
 - ♦ Helping adolescent girls connect with literature by leading small book groups
 - ♦ Helping rural high school girls create new pathways to college and/or future career goals
 - Serving as a Documentary Intern this specific role would work closely with our Communications Specialist to document the on-the-ground experiences of our Summer Program must have prior experience with photography, videography, or social media marketing
- 4. Describe any ways in which serving as a PAGE Intern might be of relevance to your academic studies and/or post-graduation goals.
- 5. Logistics: What college or university do you currently attend? Does your school (or program) provide any summer internship financial support that you could be eligible for in Summer '25?
